Happy Father's Day and Happy Pentecost! Perhaps we should say Happy Holy Spirit Day?

As we remember our own fathers and all of those people who have fathered us, we should always look to the prime example of fatherhood – God Himself. God did not create us to be simply followers but His children - brothers and sisters of Christ!

It is a high calling, of course, to compare our fatherhood with God's but it is the example we have been given. I'm sure most of us would like some things different in our fathers and the way they raised us. I always wanted my best friend's father because he seemed "cool". Turns out my best friend wanted something different as well. I look back now and see some of the things my father did for me that I didn't realize when they occurred but now, I find an example of God's love in them. Although there are many, I will share just one example here.

When I was about 5 years old, my father, brother and I were picking berries. Since I was the youngest, I was charged with bringing the buckets up to the house, emptying them, and returning. On one trip, I stepped on a rotten log, and it turned out to be a wasp's nest. Almost instantly, I was surrounded by wasps and stung. I dropped my buckets, covered my face and cried out. I remember my brother saying that I probably saw a snake, but my father told him to be quiet. He heard the buzzing and came running. The next thing I know was that I was under my dad's arm being whisked through the woods to our tool shed where we had a rain barrel. He told me to hold my breath and then plunged me under the water, thus swatting away the wasps as they floated to the surface.

Then he asked me if I was okay and brought me back to the house to change into dry clothes and treat my stings. I can still remember the awesome feeling of almost flying in my father's arms while I was being saved. It wasn't until I was much older that I learned how allergic to bee stings my father was when I had to rush him to the emergency room when I was a teenager.


I didn't realize it then, but my father risked his own life to save me! Kind of makes up for the imperfections that I focused on when I was growing up.

That is done by example. We all are not perfect, yet we can show signs of God's fatherhood when we act out of love.
