The Friar's Nook

Today, the Spirit of Jesus, the Spirit who is Jesus, continues to blow, invading everything, leading the world toward the fullness of the Kingdom. The Spirit of God is power. After Easter, the Wind of God swept the Church out into the whole world. The Gospel spread under its powerful impulse: "with power and with the Spirit" (1 Thess 1:5; 1 Cor 2:4). The Holy Wind gathered all its scattered children together. It created communities of brothers and sisters. It generated events of liberation, both interior and exterior. It made hearts open to Jesus, to his memory.

The Spirit never ages. The Wind of God never stops. It sweeps across the entire geography and history of the world. Even today, it continues to transform and transfigure. Sometimes it is a spectacular wind, at other times, a gentle breeze. It is the cause of many liberations. No one knows where it comes from or where it goes; But there it is, mobilizing everything. A Wind that brings the Holy to us. This Wind makes God present in the world effortlessly. It is not a Wind that propels us outward but rather brings the outside inward. It is not the Wind that makes us go, but the one that comes. The Holy Spirit is the presence of God in this world. God gives himself to us, and the gift is within reach. In every human experience, God gives himself to us when we feel wonder, immense peace, and joy in our hearts.

The Spirit is a powerful movement that acts within the hearts of the faithful, in that profound center where humankind is born to love. The first fruit of the Spirit is love accompanied by joy, peace, goodness, and kindness. Charity is the eschatological virtue that endures for all eternity (1 Cor 13:13). The Wind of God is "like the breath of the world" (E. König).

The wind is perceived, even if it cannot be seen. Jesus said that the world ignores the Spirit, but "you know him, for he dwells among you and will always be with you" (Jn 14:17). The Spirit cannot be known through intelligence, but through experience: "You know him because he dwells among you."

Where the Wind of God envelops us, we experience life in all its integrity, totality, and strength, as a healed and redeemed life.

The coming of the Spirit announces the arrival of Jesus in our lives. The relationship between spring and summer, sowing and harvest, dawn and noon, exists between the coming of the Spirit and the coming of Jesus.

When we ask for the coming of the Spirit, we do not want to fly to heaven, nor be transferred to the world to come; we pray that he comes here, to earth, into our history.
