The Pastor's Nook

Dear St. Joan of Arc Family, this week we reflect on the Gospel reading from Luke 10:25-37, we encounter the profound lesson of the Parable of the Good Samaritan. Jesus reveals that the opposite of love is not hate but apathy—a dangerous indifference that ignores the suffering of others. In this parable, we are called to examine our love for God and how it manifests in our love for our neighbors.

St. Joan of Arc, our patroness, exemplified this selfless love. At a young age, she was moved by a divine calling to help her country in a time of dire need. She sacrificed her personal safety and comfort to fight for justice and uplift those oppressed. As Joan declared, "I am not afraid... I was born to do this." May this week be filled with moments that inspire action, kindness, and a deeper commitment to love as Christ loved us.


Prayer to St. Michael
