The Holy Mass: The Greatest Prayer of the Church

The Eucharistic celebration, the Holy Mass, is the heart and soul of Catholic life. It is not simply a ritual or a gathering, but the living sacrifice of Christ made present for us anew. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches:

"The Eucharist is 'the source and summit of the Christian life'" (CCC 1324).

Everything we believe, live, and hope for as Catholics flows from the Eucharist and leads back to it.

At every Mass, Christ Himself is truly present: Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. What happened once on Calvary is not repeated but made present sacramentally in every Eucharistic celebration. As St. Padre Pio once said: "It would be easier for the world to survive without the sun than to do without Holy Mass."

The Mass is not our prayer alone—it is Christ's prayer to the Father, offered through the Church, on behalf of the world. This is why the Eucharist is rightly called the greatest prayer of the Church.

Why the Eucharist Is the Greatest Prayer

- 1. It is Christ's own sacrifice. In the Mass, we do not merely remember Calvary—we enter into it. The priest, acting in persona Christi, offers the very sacrifice of Jesus to the Father.
- 2. It unites heaven and earth. At Mass, angels and saints worship with us. The veil between heaven and earth grows thin, and the whole Church—living and departed—becomes one body before God.
- 3. It sanctifies us and the world. Every Mass sends us forth strengthened, forgiven, and renewed to be Christ's presence in the world.

Mass Offered for Intentions

One of the greatest treasures of the Catholic faith is that we can offer Holy Mass for various intentions. Each Mass is infinitely valuable because it draws from Christ's sacrifice. The fruits of the Mass can be applied for:

- Healing for the sick and suffering.
- Thanksgiving for blessings received, answered prayers, or milestones.
- Guidance and strength for individuals and families in need.
- The departed for souls in purgatory, who cannot pray for themselves but rely on our prayers and sacrifices.

St. John Chrysostom reminded us: "Let us help and commemorate them. If Job's sons were purified by their father's sacrifice, why should we doubt that our offerings for the dead bring them some consolation?"

No other prayer equals the power of the Mass offered for the departed. It is the greatest gift of love we can give to our beloved dead.

Whenever possible, when a Mass is offered for someone—whether living or departed—it is a beautiful witness for family members to be present. Their presence unites intention with worship, surrounding their loved one with prayer, love, and faith.

Ordinary Time Sunday

A Parish Family at the Altar

At our parish, we want to make the gift of offering Mass accessible to everyone. While the usual Mass stipend is \$20, we understand that this amount may be difficult for some families. To help more people participate in this greatest prayer of the Church, we are introducing multiple-intention Masses three times a week—Sunday at 12 PM, Wednesday, and Friday.

On these days, each Mass can be offered for multiple intentions, with a stipend of \$10 per intention. This allows more families to have their prayers and loved ones remembered each week. On the other days—Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday—Masses will continue with a single intention and a \$20 stipend.

Additionally, every Sunday 10 AM Mass is offered for the intentions of the entire parish family. Even if you cannot request a specific Mass, know that you are included and lifted before the Lord at this celebration.

This November 1st, on the Solemnity of All Saints, we will also offer a special Mass for all departed souls at 7:30 pm. Let us never neglect this sacred duty of love—for one day, we too will depend on the prayers of the living.

At the same time, let us not forget to offer Masses in thanksgiving for blessings received. The greatest way to thank God is not only with words but with the Eucharist—the very offering of His Son.

My dear friends, nothing on earth can replace the Holy Mass. No devotion, no personal prayer, no sacrifice—great as they may be—can equal the infinite value of Christ's sacrifice renewed at the altar.

O Sacrament most Holy, O Sacrament Divine, All praise and all thanksgiving, Be every moment Thine!




