## The Pastor's Nook

# World Mission Sunday: "Pray Always Without Losing Heart" (Luke 18:1)

This Sunday's liturgy invites us into the sacred rhythm of unceasing prayer and mission. Like Moses, whose raised hands brought victory to Israel (Exodus 17:8–13), we are reminded that our strength and success in life's battles come not from our own power, but from steadfast prayer and reliance on God.

When Moses' arms grew weary, Aaron and Hur supported him. What a powerful image of the Church. We are never alone in prayer. The community upholds us, and together, we uphold the world in intercession. As long as our hearts and hands are lifted toward heaven, God works His wonders among us.

St. John Chrysostom once said, "Prayer is the root, the fountain, the mother of a thousand blessings." Prayer is not a one-time act, it is a way of life, the lifeblood of our Christian mission. In today's Gospel, Jesus reminds us to "pray always and never lose heart." Persistent prayer transforms not only our circumstances but our hearts. It keeps us rooted in faith even when the answers seem delayed.

World Mission Sunday brings this truth to the forefront. The mission of the Church flows directly from prayer. As Pope Francis reminds us: "Every Christian is called to be a missionary and witness of the Gospel. Prayer is the first missionary work of every believer."

Our world thirsts for the presence of God, for compassion, peace, and justice. Each one of us, through our prayer and action, is called to bring Christ to the world beginning right where we are. When we pray, give, and serve, we participate in Christ's mission of salvation.

The Word of God, as St. Paul tells Timothy (2 Tim 3:14–4:2), must guide and sustain this mission. Through the prayerful reading of Scripture—Lectio Divina—we allow God's voice to shape our thoughts, our prayers, and our deeds.

"Ignorance of Scripture," said St. Jerome, "is ignorance of Christ." When we immerse ourselves in the Word, our hearts catch fire with divine zeal, and our prayers become one with the heartbeat of God for the world.

Let us remember: Mission begins on our knees. We cannot bring Christ to others unless we have first encountered Him in prayer. We cannot proclaim the Good News unless we have allowed it to transform us from within.

#### **Ordinary Time Sunday**

So today, let us renew our commitment to unceasing prayer and active mission. Let us lift our hearts like Moses trusting that God will bring victory. Let us persevere like the widow in the Gospel believing that God will answer in His time. And let us go forth like the apostles carrying Christ's love to every corner of our world.
