The Pastor's Nook

"Humbled Hearts, Generous Hands"

My dear Parishioners, this Sunday's readings remind us that our God is a Just Judge who looks not at outward appearances, but at the truth within our hearts. The Book of Sirach teaches that "The prayer of the humble pierces the clouds" (Sirach 35:21), assuring us that the Lord never turns away from those who come before Him in sincerity and love. In 2 Timothy 4:6–8, St. Paul speaks with deep peace and confidence: "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith." Paul's life was one of humble perseverance, poured out for the sake of Christ and His people. He trusted that the Just Judge would reward him, not because of his own merits, but because of the mercy of God.

And in today's Gospel (Luke 18:9–14), Jesus contrasts the proud Pharisee and the humble tax collector. The Pharisee boasts of his own goodness; the tax collector, however, bows low and prays, "God, be merciful to me, a sinner." Jesus teaches that true righteousness springs from humility and love, not from self-importance or spiritual pride.

As we celebrate Stewardship Weekend, these readings invite us to reflect on the connection between humility and generosity. True stewardship begins when we realize that everything we have — our time, our talents, our treasure — is a gift from God, entrusted to us for His glory and for the good of others.

St. Teresa of Calcutta once said, "We can do no great things, only small things with great love."

And St. Francis of Assisi reminds us, "For it is in giving that we receive." Stewardship is not simply about financial giving though our parish deeply depends on your continued generosity to sustain and build our ministries, maintain our facilities, and reach out to those in need. It is about a way of life, living each day with open hands and open hearts. Each one of us has something precious to offer:

- Each one of us has something precious to offer:
- Your time: by serving in ministries, attending Mass faithfully, and praying for the parish community.
- Your talents: by volunteering your skills, creativity, or leadership in parish programs and outreach.
- Your treasure: by contributing financially, even in small ways, to strengthen and grow our parish's mission.

As St. John Vianney said, "The Lord does not look at what we give, but at the love with which we give it."

When we give humbly and joyfully, we imitate the heart of Christ who, though rich, became poor for our sake (2 Cor 8:9). Our humble acts of generosity become a living testimony that love, not pride, rules our hearts.

Let this weekend be a moment to renew our commitment not only to the financial well-being of our parish, but to the spiritual and communal growth that comes when every parishioner offers themselves as a faithful steward of God's gifts.
