<u>Tuesday, July 14th</u> 5:30 pm – Bonee (Blessing)	I have often thought that St. Matthew’s Gospel demonstrates to us a kind of school of discipleship. The Sermon on the Mount, chapters 5, 6 and 7 make it rather obvious but other parts of the Gospel such as the one we read this weekend about the parable of the sower also make it clear.
<u>Wednesday, July 15th</u> 5:30 pm – Souls in Purgatory	It begins with Christ’s call, and it is effective because Christ makes us His own. Then we have some work to do as well. We need to cultivate that soil for it to receive the Word fruitfully.
<u>Thursday, July 16th</u> 5:30 pm – Stanley (Blessings)	Here are some of the teachings from the chapters 5 to 7.
<u>Friday, July 17th</u> 5:30 pm – Eustachy Kowalski +	✘ Goodness must be cultivated from the inside. What is in our heart comes to reveal virtue, our struggles and our faults.
<u>Saturday July 18th</u> 5:30 pm – Thomas Lan+	✘ As disciples we are called to live with integrity, to have a fundamental harmony between what we do and say and what lies in our soul and conscience.
<u>Sunday, July 19th</u> 10:00 am – Parish Community 12:00 pm – In memory of Rosa Paolo -Jacqueline Letourneau (Healing) -Ann Dabbay (Healing)	✘ Our relationships are not determined by our rights and entitlements but must stem from graciousness and charity, even to loving our enemies.
<u>Tuesday, July 21st</u> 5:30 pm – Souls in Purgatory	✘ Kindness and generosity need to be free of the expectation of a reward. Similarly, with spiritual disciplines, we should not look for recognition but do them with graciousness.
<u>Wednesday, July 22nd</u> 5:30 pm – Souls in Purgatory	✘ Humility and simplicity in prayer, exemplified in the compact wording of the Our Father.

- ✠ Cultivate the realization that true life comes from God and not from material things. We can safely rely on God.
- ✠ Use the senses to build up the life of discipleship and avoid taking in things that might lead to disconnection from the graciousness of God.
- ✠ Do not judge others. Instead, be aware of your own impediments to a virtuous life and work on those.
- ✠ Trust in the fruitfulness of your prayers because of the Father's love for you.
- ✠ Teachings that sum it up! Do to others as you would have them do to you. Persevere in striving to live a virtuous life and do not become discouraged.
- ✠ When looking to others, judge the quality of the fruits, that you might choose guides who are authentic.

And at the end of the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus repeats what we read this week, namely that we have to be genuine in listening to the Word and acting upon it. The parable calls this rich soil, and that's what we want to be.
